# TIPS FROM *your* DRIVER:

We'd like to remind our customers to please **NOT** place hot coals or ashes in garbage containers. Flammable materials such as, hot coals, fireworks, or hot firewood have the potential to burn up garbage carts/bins, spark a home fire, even burn up a garbage truck. Mid Valley Disposal reminds everyone to **NOT** place hot coals or ashes in garbage containers. Help avoid a fire catastrophe by following these Safety Tips.

## Safety Tips:

- Allow cooling of hot coals for at least 48 hours
- Douse hot coals in a large metal bucket of water and soak until completely cooled
- Place cooled coals in GARBAGE cart/bin NOT in recycling or green waste cart

Placement for curbside collection is incredibly easy, but it's also incredibly important to ensure your waste and recycling services are handled properly. Following the guidelines below will guarantee a smooth collection:

- All garbage & recycling carts must be placed at the curb before 6:00 a.m. on your service day.
- Push carts to the curbside on scheduled pick-up day. Lid openings should face the street.
- Set carts 3 feet apart and 6 feet, away from vehicles and fences. Please do not block carts/bins. Leave space around all carts/bins so the trucks' automated arms can grab and lift carts/bins.

**Do not overfill carts. Lids should close.**

**Drive in services, if it is to mudding bins will not be services, unsafe for our driver.**

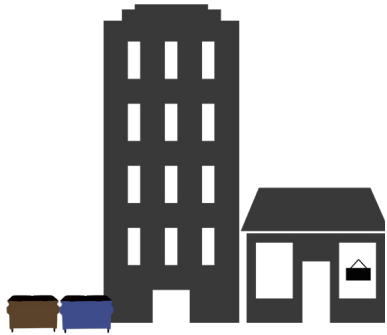

# Recycling Law AB341 Businesses & Multi-Families

Recycling Law AB341 became effective July 1, 2012. AB341 requires businesses and public entities that generate four cubic yards or more of waste per week and multi-family properties with five or more units to recycle. - Aluminum & Metal Products
  - Mixed Paper Products
  - Glass- Bottles & Jars
- Plastics- Containers, & Bottles



- Yard Trimmings- Grass Clippings, Leaves, Prunings, Plants and Branches
  - Houseplants, Cut and Dried Flowers
  - Natural/Untreated Wood
