## HOLIDAY DISPOSAL

As the holidays are approaching, we want to address how to dispose of the common waste produced during this time of year. Listed below is a list of common materials that should **NOT** be placed in your recycling container.

### MATERIAL NOT ACCEPTED IN RECYCLING CONTAINERS

- BOWS
- RIBBON
- HOLIDAY LIGHTS
- WREATHS
- GREEN WASTE
- DISPOSABLE PLATES
- PLASTIC UTENSILS
- PLASTIC CUPS

### FLAMMABLE MATERIAL

We'd like to remind our customers, please **DO NOT** place hot coals, or ashes in garbage containers. Flammable materials such as hot coals, fireworks, or hot firewood have the potential to burn up garbage carts/bins, spark a home fire, or even burn our garbage trucks. Mid Valley Disposal reminds everyone **NOT** to place hot coals or ashes in garbage containers. Help avoid a fire catastrophe by following these Safety Tips.

### SAFETY TIPS:

- Allow cooling of hot coals for at least 48 hours
- Douse hot coals in a large metal bucket of water and soak until completely cooled
- Place cooled coals in GARBAGE cart/bin and NOT in recycling or green waste cart

# ENSURING QUALITY SERVICE

We would like to remind our customers how to ensure your containers get serviced as scheduled. Beyond sorting your waste appropriately, be sure to break down boxes to save space. Container lids must be kept closed for service. Overloaded containers may result in additional services or charges on your next bill. Containers should not be blocked by anything that would prevent them from being serviced. Muddy conditions may prevent us from entering a property for service. Be aware that if your property meets a certain threshold, you may be subject to drive in fees. Please keep pets detained on service days.

## LIQUIDS

In an effort to keep our streets clean, please do not dump any liquids into your trash containers. Non-hazardous liquids must be poured fully into the sink. Hazardous liquids must be disposed of properly and safely to ensure a clean water supply for our community.
