HAZARDOUS MATERIAL

Hazardous waste is any product that is labeled as harmful, toxic, poisonous, combustible, corrosive, flammable, or irritant. HHW items include the following: Fluorescent Bulbs/Tubes, Lamps, Sharps, Paint, Alkaline & Rechargeable Batteries, Mercury/Lead Devices, Automobile Oil/Filter, Antifreeze/Coolant, Solvents. These products **CANNOT** be placed in your recycling, green waste, or garbage cart/containers. These materials should be disposed of safely and properly.

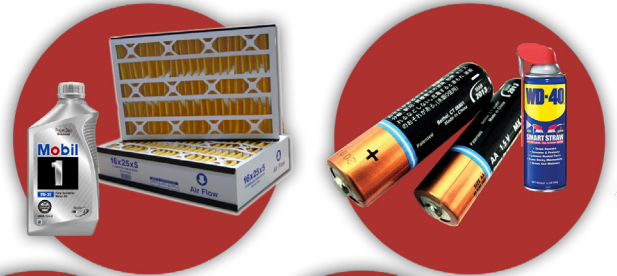

SUMMERTIME REMINDER

We'd like to remind our customers to please **NOT** place hot coals or ashes in garbage containers. Flammable materials such as, hot coals, fireworks, or hot firewood have the potential to burn up garbage carts/bins, spark a home fire, even burn up a garbage truck. Mid Valley Disposal reminds everyone to **NOT** place hot coals or ashes in garbage containers. Help avoid a fire catastrophe by following these Safety Tips.

SAFETY TIPS:

- Allow cooling of hot coals for at least 48 hours
- Douse hot coals in a large metal bucket of water and soak until completely cooled
- Place cooled coals in GARBAGE cart/bin NOT in recycling or green waste cart
